

While those dark days may be gone, the impact and the memory of the pandemic will live on for years to come. So far, Ireland has seen over 1.6 million PCR confirmed cases of the disease and there have been more than 8,270 deaths. The mix of high vaccination, booster rates and infection levels means that there is a high level of immunity for now.

An ancient Mexican site more than 1,000 years old has been declared the country's first archaeological zone in a decade. Canada de la Virgen, the modern name of an ancient Otomi ceremonial center, is located near the picturesque mountain town and tourist destination of San Miguel de Allende. The pre-Hispanic site features a large stone temple complex and other structures, many aligned with astronomical bodies, and is believed to have reached its peak around 600-900 AD, contemporaneous with dozens of major Maya cites.

It isn't clear if the fish will be able to adapt to the changes brought about by coral bleaching quickly enough, the researchers warned. Vaccination has rendered meningococcal a rare disease in Australia. So why are more cases popping up this year than last, and how can we protect our loved ones? Parents and teenagers are being urged to be on alert for meningococcal symptoms after cases were reported among young people who attended music festivals and schoolies events in recent weeks. An 18-year-old woman from NSW died of meningococcal a week after attending the Spilt Milk music festival in Canberra.

Vessels off the East Coast must slow down more often to help save a vanishing species of whale from extinction, the federal government said Friday. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration made the announcement via new proposed rules designed to prevent ships colliding with North Atlantic right whales.

Keepers at the Hampshire conservation charity are required by law each year to complete an audit of the 2,500 mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish and invertebrates in their care. Species such as Caribbean giant cockroaches and stick insects are counted in groups, but all others are recorded individually.
