Decoding them is another matter. There's no single brain area that governs thoughts of a given type; the way a person experiences thinking involves many parts of the brain operating simultaneously. Picking up all those signals that make up a thought in a real brain would require sticking electrodes into lots of different areas.

Conrad said that Wyoming at the time had a climate matching today's tropics. The newly discovered lizard used to skim the surfaces of lush, watery habitats there. The lizard's fossils suggest that, when alive, it was around 2 feet long. Conrad believes the Jesus lizard was active during the day and spent a lot of time in trees.

One interesting question about the northern noctilucent clouds is whether their behavior will shift. This year's noctilucent clouds in the Southern Hemisphere were much more variable than usual, with a big drop off in cloud frequency 15 to 25 days after the summer solstice. That's the time when they usually are most abundant.

Fast food outlets and packaged foods have long been the subject of rumors and urban legends, but this latest legend is different and can be explained by psychology. There are two components to this mistake; one is psychological and the other is cultural. So where did the illusion of a rat-shaped chicken come from?

Exfoliations typically occur in very strong granite that is free of any cracks or fractures. When the smooth granite gets hit with rain, strong winds or tectonic movement (like an earthquake), its surface can be eroded and resulting tensions in the rock cause cracks that form parallel to the existing surface.

Pluto has a ruddy yellow hue, whereas Charon's color appears to have more in common with our moon than Pluto. It is worth noting, however, that these images are still very early in the flyby game, so we'll need to be patient until we start drawing any conclusions about surface composition or whether Pluto possesses clouds in its thin exosphere.

While the remains have not been formally identified, Noah said they almost certainly include those of Lieutenant Alexander Bonnyman, who posthumously received America's highest military accolade, the Medal of Honor, for conspicuous gallantry. Bonnyman's citation says he led a series of assaults when Marines stormed the island, finally falling when he attacked a bombproof installation that was hampering the advance.

In a technical report after the mission, however, the Google Glass was not found to be ideal. It was limited by battery life and had some issues with scrolling, among other things. After this happened and for unrelated reasons, the Glass project was shelved by Google. NASA's next move is to see how Microsoft's HoloLens will do.

To jump, the robot inflates one leg in order to tilt its body in a particular direction. A combination of butane and oxygen housed up top is ignited in a spark of combustion. Once ignited, the "body," which is essentially a huge balloon, inflates rapidly pushing the robot off the ground and causing it to leap into the air.

Bowman said the spacecraft is currently taking science data as well as optical navigation data, which is "very important because it is a measure of how well we are doing on that trajectory to hit that specific point at the specific time that the science team wants us to hit. So that's pretty much what we're focused on now, is to get those science observations at the right time and at the perfect lighting conditions.

Seventeen million years after dinosaurs became extinct, the world's first known Jesus lizard walked on water in Wyoming, according to a new study. The agile reptile, described in the journal PLOS ONE, provides clues on how Jesus lizards evolved, and what their early habitats were like. Such lizards are still alive today, with the group including such well-known members as iguanas and chameleons.

Journalist Remo Sabatini caught footage of the feeding great white on a trip with White Shark Africa, a tour group, as the shark took a lure. What sounds like the heavy breathing of the shark is, in fact, the camera rubbing on the steel cage, Dan Abbott, a spokesman for White Shark Africa. In the background, another great white breaches high in the air, effectively photo bombing the feeding shark on film.

Yongki, a tame creature who worked with teams of elephant keepers, was found dead close to the camp where he lived in a national park on the western island of Sumatra, said park official Timbul Batubara. His one-metre (three-foot) tusks had been hacked off, leaving just bloody stumps, and his legs still bore the chains put on him by his keepers to ensure he stayed in the camp.

Looking at photos on our flat, rectangular screens may one day seem as antiquated as flipping through printed scrapbooks, or at least it will if Flickr's latest project works out. At the XOXO Festival in Portland, Ore., the photo-sharing network revealed its plans to immerse users in photographs using virtual reality headsets.

Zhejiang, Fujian and Guangdong provinces are forecasted to approach or even drop below the lowest levels on record while parts of central and eastern China were 6 to 8 degrees Celsius lower than the average historical level. The worst cold snap in years coincided with the beginning of a 40-day travel rush for Chinese New Year which falls on February 8 this year. There, the archaeologists found a skull with the palms of severed hands arranged over the face in opposite directions. A jaw and the first six cervical vertebrae, all bearing v-shaped cut marks, completed the assemblage.

Since the onset of the mosquito-borne disease in Brazil in 2015, it has spread to a few countries around the world, mainly in Central and South America, as well as the Caribbean. The CDC said that 36 countries in Central and South America, and the Caribbean, as well as Asia, have been listed as "alert," the second-highest level of travel advisory, while Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines and Gabon in Africa have been tagged with a travel watch, the lowest advisory.

What's important about the story of the New England Cottontail is that conservation efforts actually can, sometimes, succeed. Begun in 2008, state, federal, and private conservation efforts managed to preserve open spaces, eliminate invasive species, and recreate the rabbit's preferred thicket habitats in its historic range.

Dehydration is likely to be an important factor, but it may also be caused by some of the byproducts of fermentation. In general, darker drinks are thought to contain more congeners. In fact, the evidence so far is ambiguous. Although certain dark spirits like bourbon do seem to produce a worse hangover than crystal clear vodka, different types of beer and wine so far seem to be equal.

In the movie "Predator," an alien uses a cloaking device to hide in plain sight, but the effect is far from perfect: The alien's attempt to conceal itself is thwarted by distortions of light bending around it. Now, researchers have built an ultrathin "invisibility cloak" that gets around this problem, by turning objects into perfect, flat mirrors.

Headlining these efforts was supposed to be the HoloLens, a headset made by Microsoft that in part would allow ground controllers to look over the shoulders of astronauts. However, the Falcon 9 rocket carrying up a Dragon spacecraft exploded June 29; the cause is still being investigated. While there's no date yet on when astronauts will use it in space, it will be used underwater very shortly.

Also, because a new analysis showed the ship likely could survive re-entry with the tail section down, Galactic also decided keep the feather locked until after the ship's rocket engine had shut down. Pilots will have three- to five minutes to troubleshoot in case of problems before the feather would be needed for re-entry, Moses said.

Early humans heard sounds differently than we do today, according to new research that provides intriguing clues on the environments our ancestors were living in, and how prehistoric humans communicated with each other. A key finding of the study, published in the journal *Science Advances*, is that our ancestors living in South Africa around 2 million years ago were extremely sensitive to close-range sounds, hearing them more keenly than both our species and chimpanzees do now.

Medical experts continue to disagree over the appropriate role of the drugs, with some arguing that they should only be used for the most severe cases, such as cancer pain or end-of-life care. Among other steps, the FDA is requiring additional studies from painkiller manufacturers to assess the long-term safety and effectiveness of long-acting opioids for chronic pain.

Generally, a BMI of 25 and above indicates overweight, while 30 and above indicates obesity. Someone who is 5 feet, 9 inches would hit that obesity threshold at 203 pounds. Some people have a high BMI because they're more muscular. More common are people who harbor too little muscle and too much body fat even if their BMI is in the normal range. Body composition shifts as we age, with the proportion of muscle decreasing and the proportion of body fat increasing.

New York has, for years now, been trying to attack chronic health problems like obesity, diabetes and hypertension by warning consumers about the hidden dangers in the food they eat. The city banned the use of artery-damaging artificial trans fats in restaurant food. It tried, but failed, to impose a limit on the size of cups used to serve sugary beverages at food service establishments. Eight years ago, it began requiring chain restaurants to post calorie information on their menus, reasoning that if people knew how caloric some dishes and beverages were, they might stay away.

Yet there is growing unease over India's prospects: The country's GDP numbers have diverged from other indicators, and their quality has been questioned. India's companies are carrying high levels of debt and have failed to snap out of their funk. Mumbai's Sensex stock market index has shed about 20% in the past 12 months. Even more worrying is that many of Modi's promised reforms have failed to materialize.

Most biodiversity experts concurred that the Paris agreement was an important step forward, but none thought it would be enough to counter the vast risks posed to biodiversity by global warming. Indeed a recent study in Science found that more than 5% of the world's species will likely go extinct even if we manage to keep temperatures from rising more than 2C, the uppermost target outlined in Paris.

Especially useful for rugs or carpets. Whenever wine spills over, blot as much of it as you can with a paper towel. Otherwise, the sites were basically similar in terms of land use, cover, soil moisture and air-mass conditions. The researchers found that contrails somehow depress the difference between daytime and night time temperatures, typically decreasing the maximum and raising the minimum. In the South, the reduction in the temperature range was 6 degrees Fahrenheit, while in the Midwest it amounted to five degrees.

Farmers can buy wasps to use as pest control, though often they're done as a last-ditch option rather than for prevention since they can be kind of expensive; certainly more than spray-on pesticides. (On the other hand, you don't forfeit your organic certification if you use wasps as pest control.) The specific ways wasps are used isn't all that well understood, which a new paper, published in the Journal of Integrated Pest Management, points out.
